## Collect 10 scavenger hunt

<u>Resources</u>: an outdoor space or lots of natural materials, a container for the collection, alliteration scavenger hunt work sheet.

- Before starting the scavenger hunt discuss what may be collected from the environment without destroying it.
- Pupils go on a scavenger hunt to collect 10 different natural objects.
- Make a class display of what has been collected by grouping each type of thing together (this can be done inside or outdoors).
- Sort the collection into 10 of one thing, 9 of another, 8 of another and so on down to one.
- Pupils can observe and handle the objects before completing recording sheets featuring for example;
- adjective and noun
- alliteration and noun
- collective nouns
- Pupils may work in pairs or small groups to invent words.
