Letter tree

Using an alphabet tree to begin letter recognition and selecting appropriate words from the outdoor environment

EYFS

Early learning goals: Communication and language, Understanding the

world, Literacy

Activity type: individual/pairs/small groups

Length of activity: 5-20 minutes

Outdoor requirements: playground with a few trees or local park

Resources: individual letters with string to hang on a tree (ipads/camera

optional)

Starter activity:

Ask each child to choose a letter. Show everyone the letter and sound it out together.





Main activities:

Individually or pairs, this activity could be implemented in a variety of ways:

- Choose a letter and find something beginning with that letter.
- Choose a letter and take a picture of something beginning with that letter (using ipad or camera).
- Choose a letter, find something beginning with that letter and draw it.
- Find an object and select the letter that the word begins with.

Plenary activity:

In small groups, read together the letters that the children chose.

Taking turns, children share the object/picture that they found. Ask other children to guess the letter that it begins with.
