# Team Challenges



During the summer and early autumn terms, as well as our usual day visitors, 24 classes camped at Suntrap.





Activities included shelter building, making camp fires, orienteering, pond dipping, natural art, learning about the Suntrap animals and a variety of team challenges - including trying to build the tallest bamboo tower, using only masking tape.

## Summer Holiday Activities

Schools may be closed during the summer holidays - but Suntrap stays open. This year we welcomed Epping Forest Sports Inclusion group for 3 day visits, Chance UK had a day enjoying making camp fires and meeting the Suntrap animals and Suntrap took part in the Waltham Forest Holiday Activities Programme, free activities for 0-19 year olds who live in the borough.

The Suntrap animals had trips to a number of drop-in family play sessions in schools. Meanwhile, back at Suntrap teenagers got to learn the art of bush craft including navigation, shelter building, fire lighting and campfire cooking including making nettle soup with campfire bread, followed by cake cooked in a scooped out orange with blackberries.

Open Day Saturday 8th October, 1-5pm (drop-in)


Free entry - £3 charge for parking.
